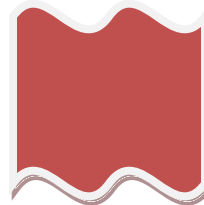

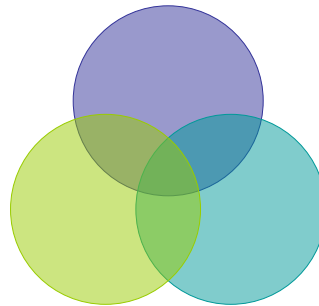
Participant will be able to understand The Americans with Disabilities Act that protects disabled Americans.
